

Help for international PhD and postdoctoral scholars

On 1 August the International Help Desk (IHD) opened at Aarhus University. The IHD is a service office for international PhD and postdoctoral scholars, a place where you can get practical and administrative help to solve any problems arising in connection with your studies and work at Aarhus University or your residence in Denmark.

You can also find information on the IHD homepage at www.au.dk/ihd. Here you can also sign up for the IHD Newsletter, which comes out once a month.

The IHD provides services in all the nine main areas at the university (six faculties, the School of Education, the School of Business and the National Environmental Research Institute). However, some services are limited in their geographical scope, and are currently only available to scholars studying and working in Aarhus.

The IHD offers help in the following fields:

- Residence and work permits
- Social issues (tax, health insurance, CPR identity numbers etc.)
- Housing (Aarhus only)
- Danish language courses (Aarhus only)
- Cultural activities and sport

The office is open twice a week for inquiries in person or by telephone.
